

## Organs of the *Palais du Luxembourg*

There seem to have been several instruments before the construction of a small organ in 1844. The origin and builder of that instrument are unknown. The composition was as follows:

### **I clavier**

Bourdon 8'  
Flûte 8 (Dessus)  
Prestant 4'  
Euphone 8'

The instrument was restored in 1928. On that occasion, it was equipped with an independent pedal of 18 notes. The composition was as follows:

### **I clavier**

Principal 8' (15 pipes *en façade*)  
Flûte bouchée 4'  
Octavin 2'  
Nazard 2'  $\frac{2}{3}$

### **Pédale**

Soubasse 16'

The instrument was dismantled at an unknown date (probably looted by the Germans in 1943).
